

EHES Kindergarten Supply List 2017-18

Option 1:

\$30 will be collected for each child, at student testing conferences in July, to purchase the following school supplies, as well as various supplies for projects throughout the school year. This saves money and allows us to purchase supplies for special class lessons and projects as needed to meet curriculum needs. It also helps us to buy the appropriate colors and sizes to help kindergarteners learn important organizational skills, such as sorting, classifying and color coding.

Option 2:

Parents have the option to purchase supplies and send those to school rather than paying the supply fee. If you chose this option, please provide **ONLY** those items on the list below. Also, please send in the quantities, colors, styles and brands requested. This is due to the importance of consistent, structured management routines for kindergarten students, **which include color coding and matching items for sorting**. We have also discovered, through many years of experience, that poor quality brands do not hold up to kindergarten students through the school year and frequently need to be replaced. Please **DO NOT** label items with your child's name.

2 three-ring binders (1/2 inch)-white with see through front cover (to be used for your child's home communications binder and data binder)

2 sets binder dividers with tabs (sets of 5 dividers)

2 pencil pouches vinyl with zipper

8 pocket folders with brad fasteners (solid colors: 2 red, 2 yellow, 2 blue, 2 green; **No pictures or decorations please**)

3 boxes of 24 **Crayola** crayons

3 boxes of 24 writing pencils

3 boxes of 24 **Crayola** colored pencils

1 pair **student** scissors

3 bottles **Elmer's** liquid glue

8 **Elmer's** glue sticks

4 large erasers

4 fine tip **black** dry erase markers (**low odor**)

1 large box facial tissue
