

Inclement Weather Dismissal

In case of inclement weather dismissal, the process to keep students dry and loaded in vehicles as quickly and safely as possible is listed below. On days of severe weather, administration decides if inclement dismissal is necessary about fifteen minutes prior to the dismissal bell.

Bus Riders

Students who ride buses have designated classrooms they report to, with duty staff. They wait in their designated classroom until the bus arrives, at which point they are escorted by duty staff to load the bus.

Red Lot Parent Pick Up

Students who are picked up in red lot (k/1st and older siblings), wait under the canopy cover in the front of the school to load their cars with supervision and assistance from duty staff. As cars arrive duty staff works to get student names communicated and students escorted as quickly as possible to their cars for loading.

Blue Lot Parent Pick Up

2nd/3rd grade students who are picked up in the blue lot report to the second grade hallway where they wait with duty staff. 4th/5th grade students who are picked up in the blue lot report to the portable next to blue lot where they wait with duty staff. Blue lot duty leaders work to get parent names to designated duty staff for blue lot students to be escorted as quickly as possible to their cars for loading.

SAFE Students

Students who attend SAFE, report to their SAFE portables as usual.
